SO DO NOT PUT A LIMIT ON WHAT YOU BELIEVE GOD CAN DO!!!




From that *time* many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. John 6:66

The falling away...

Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ³, and by our gathering together unto him,

That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

Let no man deceive you by any means: for *that day shall not come*, <u>except there</u> <u>come a falling away first</u>¹, and that man of sin be revealed², the son of perdition; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3



Is lukewarm Christianity compatible with the fear of the Lord???.....If not, what will happen to those that have been lukewarm for years?....Will they humbly repent or fall away?

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. Revelation 3:14-22

Let us look at the meaning of the word spew

So when The Lord says He will spue the lukewarm out of His mouth....He is showing us a very vivid picture of a sudden and violent rejection of the lukewarm believers.

Further, because the Lord says they are spued out of his **mouth**.....Does this represent a rejection of the lukewarm by the body.....ie the lukewarm are rejected by the body of Christ?

For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?

Joshua

Chapter 6

And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD.

Revelation

Chapter 6

- 1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.
- 2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.
- **3** And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.
- **4** And there went out another horse *that was* red: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.
- 5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see.

And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

- **6** And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and *see* thou hurt not the oil and the wine.
- 7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.
- **8** And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.
- **9** And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:
- 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- 11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they *were*, should be fulfilled.
- 12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;
- 13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.
- 14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.
- 15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;
- 16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- 17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

Revelation 6 (66th book of the Bible, 66th book, 6th chapter)

Ecclesiastes

Chapter 7

- 1 A good name *is* better than precious ointment; and the day of death than the day of one's birth.
- 2¶ *It is* better to go to the house of mourning, than to go to the house of feasting: for that *is* the end of all men; and the living will lay *it* to his heart.
- **3** Sorrow *is* better than laughter: for by the sadness of the countenance the heart is

made better.

- **4** The heart of the wise *is* in the house of mourning; but the heart of fools *is* in the house of mirth.
- 5 It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise, than for a man to hear the song of fools.
- **6** For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so *is* the laughter of the fool: this also *is* vanity.
- 7 ¶ Surely oppression maketh a wise man mad; and a gift destroyeth the heart.
- **8** Better *is* the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: *and* the patient in spirit *is* better than the proud in spirit.
- **9** Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of fools.
- 10 Say not thou, What is *the cause* that the former days were better than these? for thou dost not enquire wisely concerning this.
- 11 ¶ Wisdom is good with an inheritance: and by it there is profit to them that see the sun.
- **12** For wisdom *is* a defence, *and* money *is* a defence: but the excellency of knowledge *is, that* wisdom giveth life to them that have it.
- **13** Consider the work of God: for who can make *that* straight, which he hath made crooked?
- 14 In the day of prosperity be joyful, but in the day of adversity consider: God also hath set the one over against the other, to the end that man should find nothing after him.
- **15** All *things* have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a just *man* that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked *man* that prolongeth *his life* in his wickedness.
- **16** Be not righteous over much; neither make thyself over wise: why shouldest thou destroy thyself?
- 17 Be not over much wicked, neither be thou foolish: why shouldest thou die before thy time?
- **18** *It is* good that thou shouldest take hold of this; yea, also from this withdraw not thine hand: for he that feareth God shall come forth of them all.
- 19 Wisdom strengtheneth the wise more than ten mighty *men* which are in the city.
- 20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.
- **21** Also take no heed unto all words that are spoken; lest thou hear thy servant curse thee:
- 22 For oftentimes also thine own heart knoweth that thou thyself likewise hast cursed others.
- 23 ¶ All this have I proved by wisdom: I said, I will be wise; but it was far from me.
- 24 That which is far off, and exceeding deep, who can find it out?
- **25** I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason *of things*, and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness *and* madness:
- **26** And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart *is* snares and nets, *and* her hands *as* bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her.
- 27 Behold, this have I found, saith the preacher, counting one by one, to find out the

account:

28 Which yet my soul seeketh, but I find not: one man among a thousand have I found; but a woman among all those have I not found.

29 Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions.

Ecclesiastes 7 (666th chapter of the Bible)

Seek success for the life that is to come....not for this life.

For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, **having** promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

1 Timothy 4:8

In order to be a part of the group of 2 witnesses will you have to give up success in this life (ie worldly success)

And I will give *power* unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred *and* threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.
